

CHARLES W. POSTILL

Charles W. Postill was born in Pulaski county, 2 miles south of Medaryville. He graduated from the Winamac High School, then from DePauw University, receiving his degree in 1895. He served in the Northwest Indiana Conference for 21 years, starting in 1891. His charges included: Fontanet, Wingate, Remington, Fowler, Attica, Roselawn and Fair Oaks, In 1916 he entered retirement, in 1926 was placed in Supernumerary Relation.

Making his home in Rensselaer, he supplied pulpits from time to time, officiated at weddings, or funerals when asked, and the Sacrament of baptism when requested. He continued in these limited services until his death on August 26, 1953, at the age of 85 years.

His wife was Rebecca Richardson, daughter of Daniel L. and Elizabeth Jane Richardson. They were married at her home in Rensselaer on Sep. 3, 1890, and enjoyed 52 years of life together. She died Aug. 6, 1961. There were no children. They are buried in Weston cemetery, Rensselaer.
